

Residential Single-Stream Recycling Program

We are pleased to announce a new residential single-stream recycling program for the citizens of Star City. The Single-Stream Recycling Program will return to being a CURBSIDE PICKUP once per week. Clear plastic bags, provided by the Sanitation Department, will be collected from the front curb area every Thursday (excluding holidays). Clear bags will be available at City Hall. Customers with special needs should contact the office to discuss other accommodations.

The Acceptable Items (as listed below) **DO NOT** need to be separated, **ALL ITEMS CAN BE BAGGED TOGETHER**. Smaller, flattened cardboard/chipboard items may be collected into a larger cardboard box and placed alongside the bags. Any items (other than cardboard) not bagged will not be collected. Clear bags are to be used for recyclables **ONLY**. If bags contain non-recyclables, they will not be collected.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Plastic-numbers 1 through 7 (number located on bottom of item)
- Aluminum cans-please rinse
- Steel and bi-metal cans-please rinse
- Glass (clear, amber, green)-please rinse
- Chipboard (cereal, pasta, tissue boxes, etc.)
- Junk mail/office paper/shredded paper
- Magazines/Catalogs
- Newspapers
- Paperback books (including telephone books)
- Hardcover books (with covers REMOVED)
- Corrugated cardboard, including pizza box TOPS (no wax coating or grease marks)
- Milk/juice cartons with "gable" tops (where the top is pushed to open as a spout)
- Juice/soy milk boxes (aseptic containers)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Garbage of any kind
- Plastic wrap/plastic freezer bags/deli packaging
- Aluminum foil or containers
- Ceramics
- Mirrors
- Fluorescent light tubes/CFL bulbs/light bulbs
- Batteries
- Styrofoam/packing peanuts
- Bubble wrap
- Scrap metal
- Tires or rubber of any kind
- Chemicals/oil/paint
- Plastic not marked with a number 1-7
- Dishes/pots/pans
